



SIMPLE PRESENT (REVISION) – COMPLETE WITH THE CORRECT FORM

E.g. Sue runs 3 miles every morning but her friends Mike and Mary run only 1 mile.

1. Mandy (wake) up at 5 o'clock every morning, but her parents (wake) up at 8 o'clock.
2. My sister always (eat) vegetables for dinner, and I (eat) some salads.
3. John (prepare) breakfast at 8 o'clock, and his brother and sister (have) breakfast at 9 o'clock.
4. Benny and Tammy (go) for a walk every evening. Pit sometimes (go) for a walk with them.
5. We (work) 9 hours a day, and she (work) only 6 hours a day.
6. I (surf) the Internet every evening, but my brother only (use) the Internet at the weekend.
