1) Mrs. Young is moving boxes to her new room. The difference between the two boxes is 0.479 kg. The first box is 1.23 kg. The second box is heavier. How much does the second box weigh?



2) Ahsan ran 2.457 km on Saturday and 3.169 km on Sunday.

a) How much did he run in total?

b) How much further did he run on Sunday than on Saturday?

3) Annabelle is making fruit punch. She has 1.36 L of orange juice, 1.36 L of pineapple juice and 0.355 L of apple juice. Will she have enough to fill a 3 L punch bowl?

4) Laya is tracking the weight of a new puppy. At birth, it was 0.475 kg. At 6 weeks it was 4.06kg. By 12 weeks it was 9.25 kg.

a) How much has the puppy's weight changed by from birth to 6 weeks?

b) How much has her weight changed by from 6 weeks to 12 weeks?
