Paired conjunctions	Coordinating conjunction
<i>Both ...and / not only...but also / either...or / neither ...nor</i> → Correlative conjunctions work in pairs to join words, phrases, or clauses. It is also called (paired conjunction)	<i>And / but / or / so / yet</i> <u>Independent Clauses</u> An independent clause is a group of words that includes a subject and verb. It expresses a complete thought, and can stand alone as a sentence.
