Women's Suffrage is the right of women by law to vote. It started with the Seneca Falls Convention in the year 1848. On August 18, 1920, Tennessee played a pivotal role in the ratification of the 19th amendment. The 19th amendment states that citizen's right to vote shall NOT be denied by the United States or any state on account of gender. Tennessee provided the 36th and the final state needed to ratify the amendment federally.
