



Quarter – pound beef patty with two strips of bacon, lettuce and tomato.



PASSAGE 2

FROGS and TOADS

A frog's skin hangs loosely on their body and the skin texture also varies from one animal to another, although most frogs have moist and smooth skin. Many frogs, especially those that live in water, have webbed toes. Some frogs contain mild toxins that make them distasteful for potential predators.

Toads tend to have dry, bumpy, and possibly warty skin. Toads have a shorter body and their legs are often described as stubby or muscular. Frogs, on the other hand, tend to have longer legs. The frog's eyes tend to be protuberant and bulge out of their bodies, which is not the case for toads.

Frogs and toads have similar diets. They are omnivorous, feeding on insects, worms, small fish, algae, and other swamp creatures.

In general, frogs prefer a moist environment, while toads have adapted to both dry and moist environments.

Due to their longer legs, frogs are capable of very long jumps, while toads move only in short hops.
