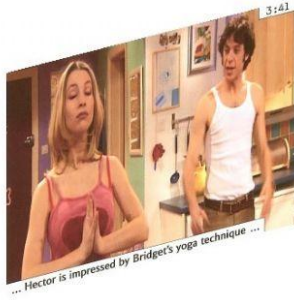


# Bridget wins the lottery
