## Your-you're/ his-he's/their-they're

Possessive adjectives	Pronoun + be
<b>My</b> car is broken	<b>I'm</b> (= I am) at the mechanics
<b>Your</b> car is broken	<b>You're</b> (= you are) at the mechanics
<b>His</b> car is broken	<b>He's</b> (= he is ) at the mechanics
<b>Their</b> car is broken	<b>They're</b> (= they are ) at the mechanics
