

USE OF ENGLISH

1st CONDITIONAL

We use the 1st conditional for probable situations in the present or future.

If + present simple + will / won't + base form

SITUATION	RESULT
If you (have) kids one day,	you (understand).
If people (not go) to circuses with animals,	the circuses (change).
If I (have) time next week,	I (start) an email campaign.

will / won't + base form + if + present simple

RESULT	SITUATION
You (find) a lot of information about it	if you (look) on the internet.
What children (think)	if they (see) your campaign?

We use might instead of will if the result isn't certain.

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
