Water freezes at 0 C.

in the morning/
afternoon/evening,
at night,
on Mondays/
Tuesdays, etc.

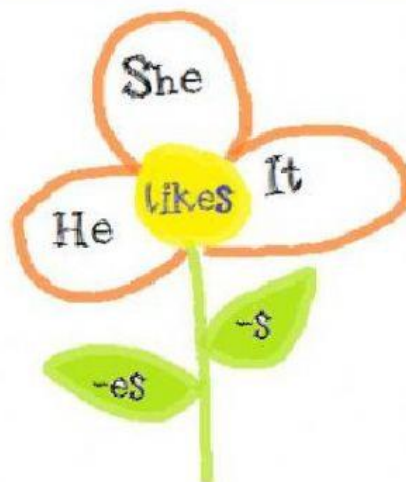

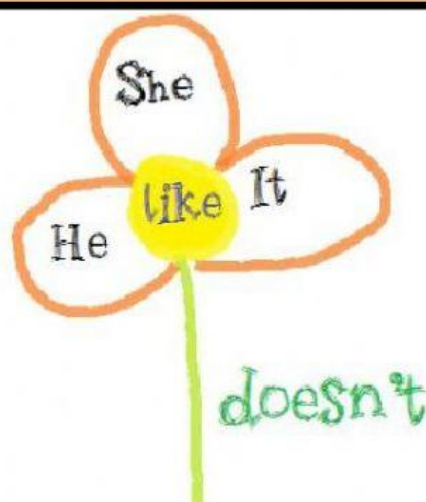

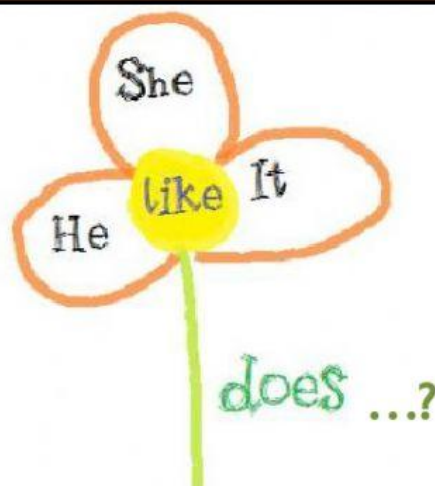
