



# Subject and predicate in english sentences



We have two parts for any sentence: subject, which is the person/thing doing the action, and the predicate, which is what is said from the subject and answers what it is doing.

We can identify who is the subject by asking: who, whose or what is doing the action?

## For instance...

If we say...

The house is scary
