Subject and predicate in english sentences

We have two parts for any sentece: subject, which is the person/thing doing the action, and the predicate, which is what is said from the subject and answers what it is doing.

We can identify who is the subject by asking: who, whose or what is doing the action?

For instance...

If we say...

The house is scary

The Volkswagen beetle released more than 50 years ago in Mexico was my father's first car Who is the subject?
