

7:45 • It's seven forty-five. • It's fifteen to eight. It's quarter to eight.	7:55 • It's seven fifty-five. It's five to eight.		



We use **AT + TIME** when giving the time of a specific event.

- The class starts at nine o'clock.
- The flight leaves at ten to three.

We use **IT IS** or **IT'S** to answer a question that asks for the time right now.

- What time is it? - It is half past four.
What's the time? - It's twenty to five.
