

## QUESTION TAGS

A question tag is a short question at the end of a statement. It's used when asking for agreement or confirmation.

### Examples:

You are a student, aren't you?

She didn't understand the question, did she?

John has passed the exam, hasn't he?

## STRUCTURE

<b>Positive</b> statement + <b>negative</b> question tag. (aux not 😊 ?)	<b>Negative</b> statement + <b>positive</b> question tag. (aux 😊 ?)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• They are tired, aren't they?</li><li>• She works in an office, doesn't she?</li><li>• We've got a small flat, haven't we?</li><li>• Bill enjoyed the film, didn't he?</li><li>• She can swim very well, can't she?</li><li>• I am late, aren't I?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• They aren't here, are they?</li><li>• He doesn't like the office, does he?</li><li>• We have never seen the film, have we?</li><li>• Nobody left a message, did they?</li><li>• My sister can't drive, can she?</li><li>• I'm not late, am I?</li></ul>
