Use **I'd rather/ I'd prefer** to talk about preferences.

	Abbreviation	Form	Example
I would rather	I'd rather	S + would rather + V1	I don't want to go to the swimming pool. I'd rather <u>go</u> to the beach.
I would prefer	I'd prefer	*Subject + would prefer + to + v1 * Subject + would prefer + v-ing	*I'd prefer <u>to have</u> a coffee. *I'd prefer <u>having</u> a coffee.
