

THE SOUNDS OF

HALLOWEEN

JOIN THE WORD WITH THE CORRECT DEFINITION.

CREAKY (ADJ.)

THE SUDDEN LOUD NOISE THAT COMES FROM THE SKY ESPECIALLY DURING A STORM

HOWL (VERB)

TO MAKE A LONG, SAD SOUND

GROWL (VERB)

TO MAKE THE SOUND OF A BELL

RING (VERB)

THE LOUD, ROUGH CRY OF A BIRD SUCH AS A CROW

CAW (VERB)

A FLASH OF BRIGHT LIGHT IN THE SKY THAT IS PRODUCED BY ELECTRICITY

LIGHTNING (NOUN)

THUNDER (NOUN)

(OF ANIMALS, ESPECIALLY DOGS) TO MAKE A LOW SOUND IN THE THROAT, USUALLY AS A SIGN OF ANGER

SCREECH (VERB)

OLD AND NOT IN GOOD CONDITION

TO MAKE AN UNPLEASANT, LOUD, HIGH NOISE:

SCREAM (VERB)

TO MAKE A SHORT, VERY HIGH CRY OR SOUND:

BEAT (VERB)

TO MAKE A REGULAR MOVEMENT OR SOUND

ACKLE (VERB)

A TOOL USED FOR CUTTING WOOD:

DRAG (VERB)

TO CRY OR SAY SOMETHING LOUDLY AND USUALLY ON A HIGH VOICE, ESPECIALLY BECAUSE OF STRONG EMOTIONS SUCH AS FEAR, EXCITEMENT, OR ANGER:

SQUEAK (VERB)

AXE (NOUN)

TO MAKE THE LOUD, UNPLEASANT SOUND OF A CHICKEN

CHOP (VERB)

TO MOVE SOMETHING BY PULLING IT ALONG A SURFACE, USUALLY THE GROUND:

JOIN THE SCARY HALLOWEEN SOUNDS WITH THEIR NAMES.
