



MAKING INFERENCES NOTES



Inferences are **logical guesses** that can be made based on received or viewed information. To make an **inference**, the reader must put together the information provided and their prior knowledge to draw a conclusion about a situation.



Example:

Mummy gathered onions, sweet peppers, cucumbers, celery, tomatoes, a lime and an orange. She grabbed the conch soaking in salt and lemon juice.

What is mummy getting ready to do? What information did you use to make this inference?

You can infer that mummy is going to make conch salad.
