- Composed of people with similar activities and interests
- The length of time between the beginning and the end of some occurrence
- A member of a state or union
- The science of dates which attempts to place past events in a correct sequence, system of measuring time
- A period of ten consecutive years
- A period of a hundred years long
- A period of a thousand years long
- The period of time between the birth of a group & the the birth of their children (approximately 20-30 yrs)

- A very long period of time

- The error of placing persons, things or events in the wrong period of time, A historical error
