

How to Write an Opinion Essay

Objective

In this lesson, you will practice the OREO strategy to write an opinion essay. An opinion is a belief, judgement, or the expression of the way you feel about something. It is not necessarily a fact for everyone. To write an "Opinion Essay" think OREO!



Opinion: Tell your readers HOW you feel about something.

Reason: Tell your readers WHY you feel that way.

Example/Explanation: Give your readers examples of why you feel that way.

Opinion: tell your readers again WHY you feel the way you do.

You can use these **sentence starters** to help make your opinion/persuasive writing flow smoothly. Be careful to choose your sentences starters carefully. Make sure that the words you have chosen make sense as you reread your text.
