



AVOID UNNECESSARY REPETITION



When we have more than one Present Progressive verb, we don't need to repeat the subject or auxiliary verb.

Cuando tenemos más de un verbo en presente progresivo, no necesitamos repetir el sujeto o el verbo auxiliar.

She's sitting in the lounge **and she's**
eating a chocolate cake **and she's**
watching TV.

She's eating in the lounge, eating a chocolate
cake and watching TV.
