



House vs Home



The word *home* is used when we mean the place of our permanent dwelling, in which we usually live with our family. It can also refer to the place, such as a country or town, where somebody was born or has lived for many years. It is generally associated with happiness and security.

The word *house*, on the other hand, is used when talking about a building, a general physical structure which can be either a flat, cottage or caravan. Frequently, we don't feel emotional about it and stay there temporarily.
