One morning, Amirah rang her best friend Zatil.

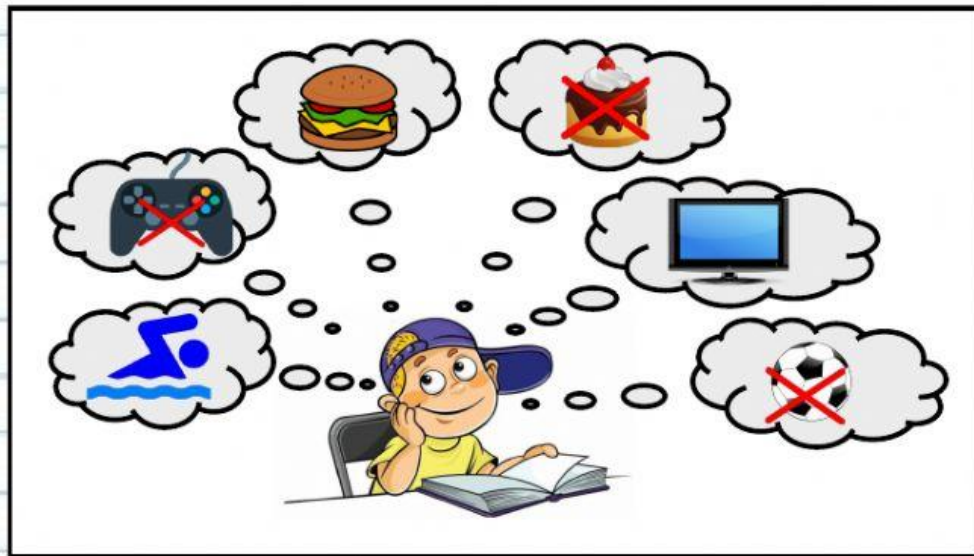
"Hi Zatil! Can you come to my house to play?"
