

Usain Bolt

1. Bolt was born in August 1986 in Sherwood Content, a small town in Trelawny, Jamaica. He grew up with his parents, Wellesley and Jennifer Bolt, his brother Sadiki, and his sister Sherine.



2. When he was 14 he won his first high school championships medal in 2001. He is the youngest gold medalist of the World Junior Championship, winning the 200 m at age of only 15.



3. His Olympic victories are remarkable. At the Beijing Summer Olympics, Bolt broke the world record in the 100-meter final, winning in 9.69 seconds. At the 2012 Summer Olympic Games in London, he won three gold medals.

4. He is one of the most marketable sportsmen in the world, and the most valuable name in the field of Athletics. His contract with Puma is estimated at around \$5 million a year.

5. When he was a child, Bolt spent his time playing cricket and football in the street with his brother. Before he was a sprinter, Usain Bolt's first sport was cricket where he specialized as a fast bowler. His love for the game still persists and is a fond admirer of Chris Gayle, a famous Jamaican cricketer. Bolt also loves dancing and music.
