

How to Plant Cassava Step-by-Step

STEP 1

Get some cassava sticks about
100 centimeters long.



STEP 2

Measure the cassava sticks

30 centimeters long.



STEP 3

Put a marking at the 30 centimeters mark and do so for every other 30 centimeters until there is no more length to measure.



STEP 4

Let an adult cut the cassava sticks into smaller sticks at the 30 centimeter marks and then let them give it to you.

STEP 5

Stick one end of the cassava stick into the dirt, up to 20 centimeters down into the ground.



STEP 6

Scoop up some dirt around the cassava stick to make it stand firm and stay upright.

This is called molding.



STEP 7

Next, stick the other cassava sticks

33.33 centimeters apart along the garden bed.

STEP 8

Plant until all of the cassava sticks have been placed in a straight line on your garden beds.
