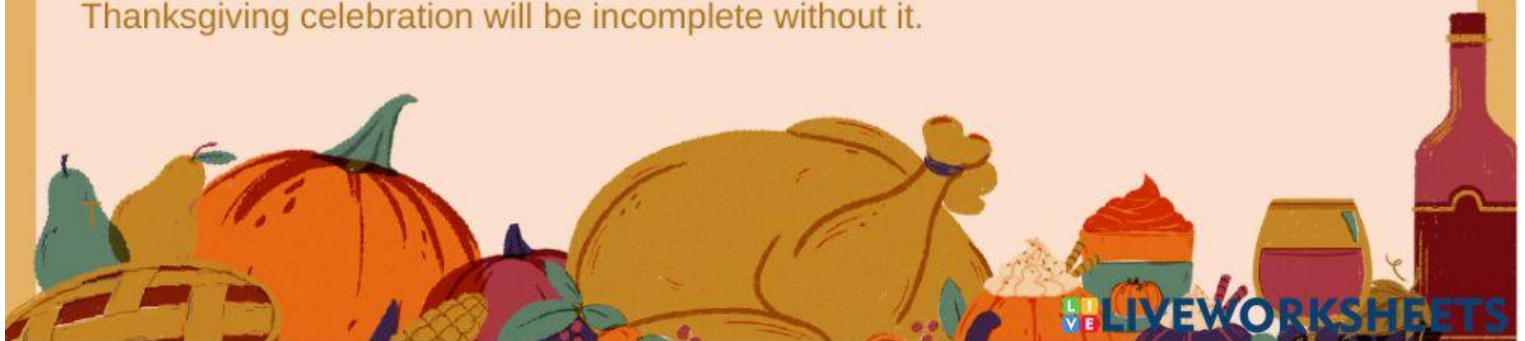




The first Thanksgiving was a three day feast. Prior to dining, they all praised the Lord and thanked him for all the food and _____ he gave them. This is how the festivity got started.


