Time only ticks on

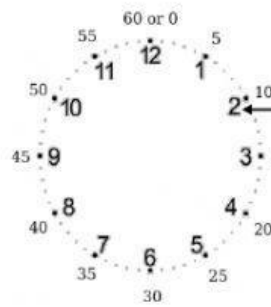
And this is why clocks was born

1 year	365 days
1 year	12 months

1 day	24 hours
1 hour	60 minutes
1 minute	60 seconds

1 Month

28, 30 or 31 days

30 days has September, April, June and November.
All the rest have 31 except February alone,
which has 28 days clear,
and 29 each leap year.

24 hours = 1 day

7 days = 1 week

52 weeks = 1 year

365 days = 1 year
