THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING

The Empire State Building is a skyscraper in New York in the USA. It's 443m high and there are 103 floors. Visitors can take a lift to the 80th floor. It takes one minute – that's quicker than the stairs! They can then walk up the stairs or get another lift up to the observation deck on the 86th floor. For the best views of the island of Manhattan, go to the 102nd floor.

About four million visitors visit this tourist attraction each year and there are often long queues, but it's worth the wait.

The tallest building in New York is the One World Trade Center. It's 541 m high. There are a lot of very tall buildings in Manhattan, and you can see them all from Brooklyn Bridge.
