Frequency or intensity



Corro más *que* tú.
(I run more than you)

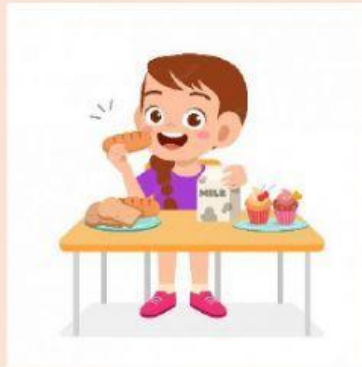

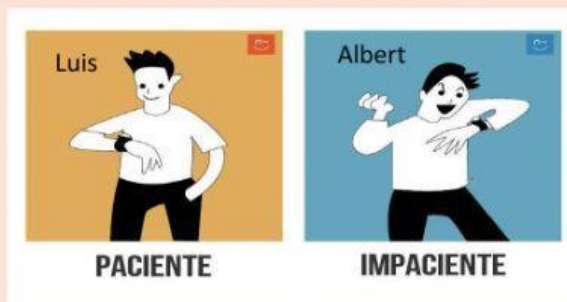

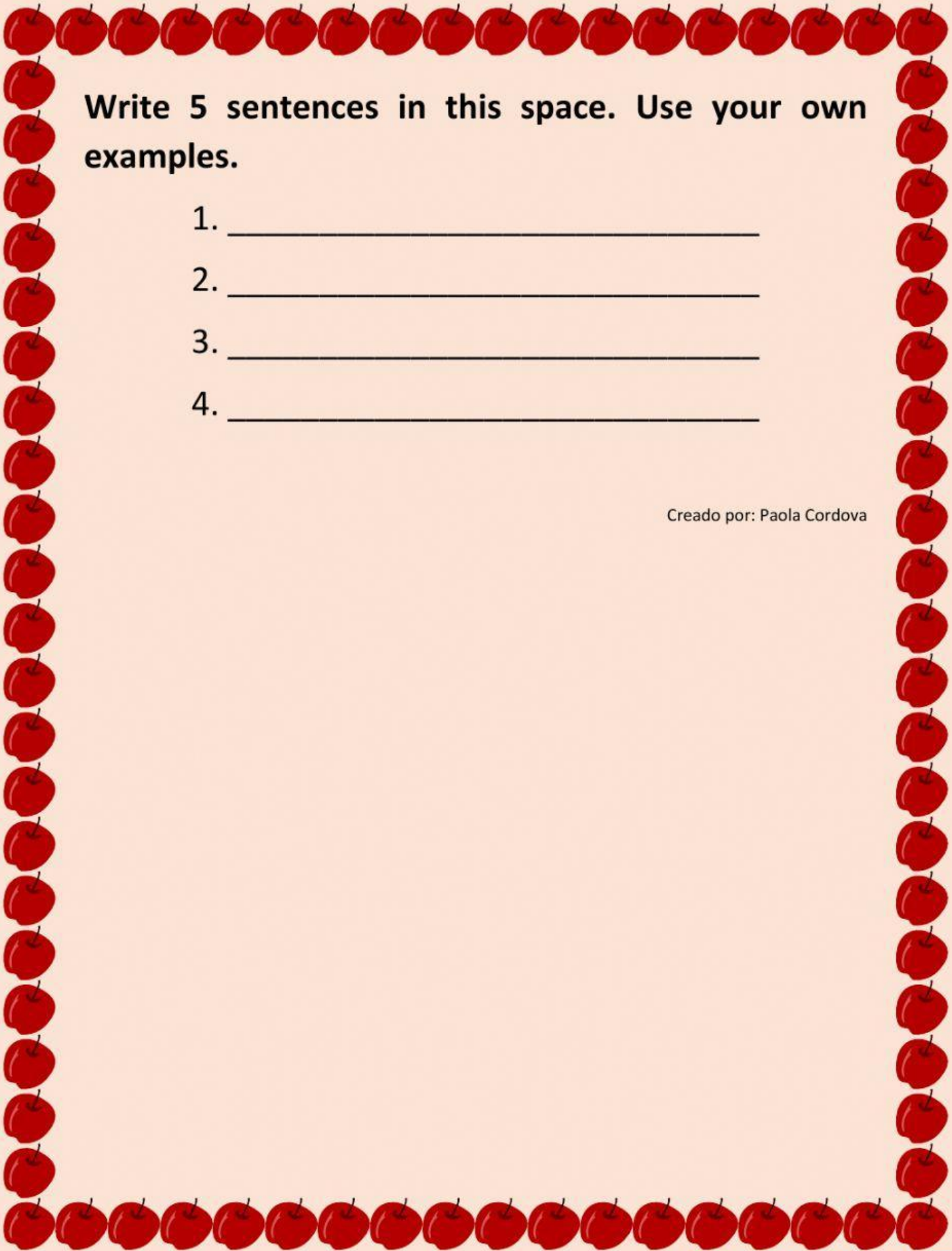
