

PRESENT PERFECT

Read the examples:

I've forgotten his name.	She hasn't washed the car.	Have you made a cake?
↑ Affirmative	↑ Negative	↑ Question

Read the explanation:

The present perfect **always** connects the *past* with the *present*.

The action in the past has **a result now**.

I've forgotten his name. (= I can't remember it now.)
She hasn't washed the car. (= It isn't clean now.)
Have you made a cake? (= Is there a cake now?)

Form:

To form the present perfect, we use **HAVE** or **HAS** + **the PAST PARTICIPLE of the VERB**.

<p>Past participle of REGULAR VERBS:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">You add -ED.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">wash -----> washed</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">live -----> lived</p>	<p>Past participle of IRREGULAR VERBS:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">You need to check the list of irregular verbs (third column).</p>
