No, she **doesn't**.

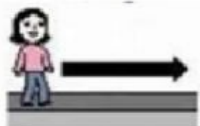

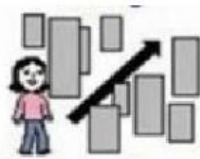
