Elhozta a gyerkőc .	Plural, Accusative	<i>She brought the kids.</i>
Láttam egy mad . (madár)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I saw a bird.</i>
Leszálltak a mad .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The birds have descended.</i>
Óvd a mad .	Plural, Accusative	<i>Protect the birds.</i>
Lezárják a hid . (híd)	Singular, Accusative	<i>The bridge is being closed off.</i>
Szépek ezek a hid .	Plural, Nominative	<i>These bridges are beautiful.</i>
Lerombolták a hid .	Plural, Accusative	<i>The bridges were destroyed.</i>
Megsimogattam a nyul . (nyúl)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I stroked the rabbit.</i>
Elszaladtak a nyul .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The rabbits ran away.</i>
Nézd meg a nyul .	Plural, Accusative	<i>Look at the rabbits.</i>
Kivágta a bokr . (bokor)	Singular, Accusative	<i>He cut the bush out.</i>
Vannak ott bokr .	Plural, Nominative	<i>There are bushes.</i>
Keresd a bokr .	Plural, Accusative	<i>Search for the bushes.</i>
Elhagyja a term . (terem)	Singular, Accusative	<i>She is leaving the room.</i>
Ezek tágas term .	Plural, Nominative	<i>These are spacious halls.</i>
Bezárták a term .	Plural, Accusative	<i>The halls have been closed.</i>
Vettem egy ökr . (ökör)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I have bought an ox.</i>

Megőrültek az ökr	Plural, Nominative	<i>The oxen have gone mad.</i>
Kiengedem az ökr	Plural, Accusative	<i>I let the oxen out.</i>
Szeretem ezt a majm (majom)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I like this monkey.</i>
A fán ülnek a majm	Plural, Nominative	<i>The monkeys are sittin gon the tree.</i>
Fényképezd le a majm	Plural, Accusative	<i>Take a photo of the monkeys.</i>
