The rain gets worse. And it is a dangerous road.

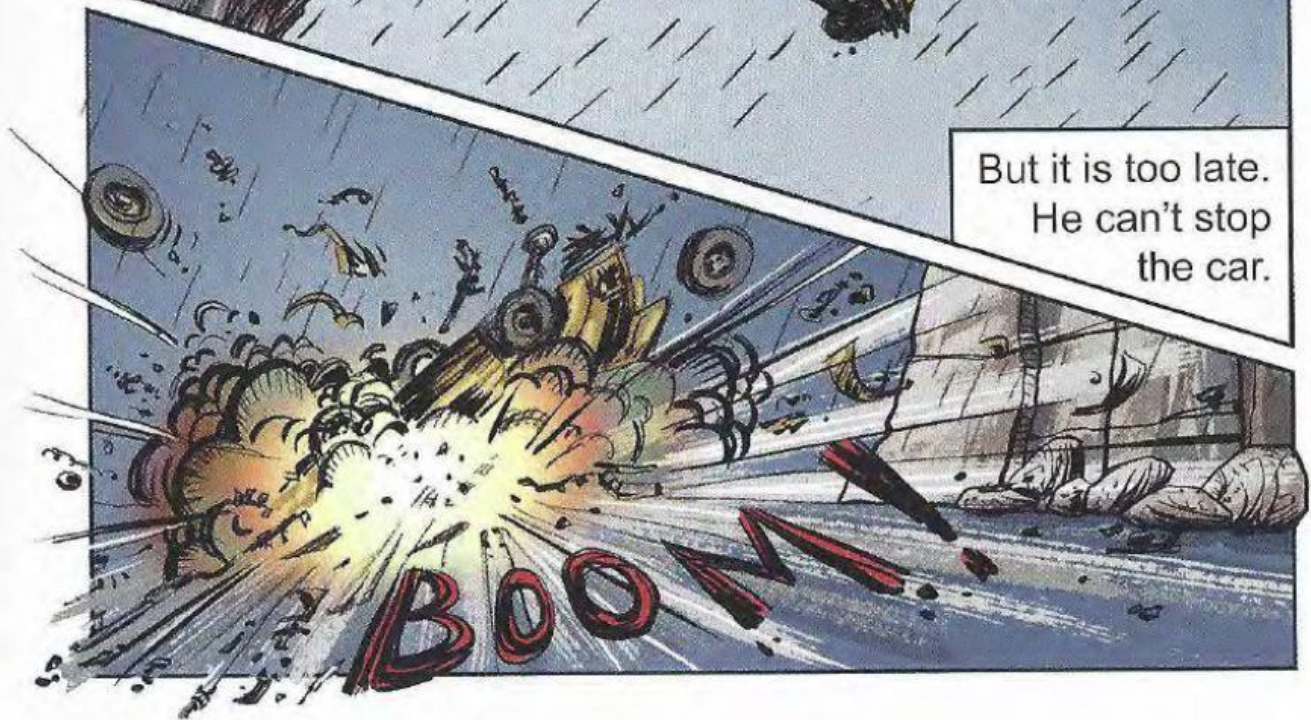


Suddenly, the car goes off the road!

No! NO!

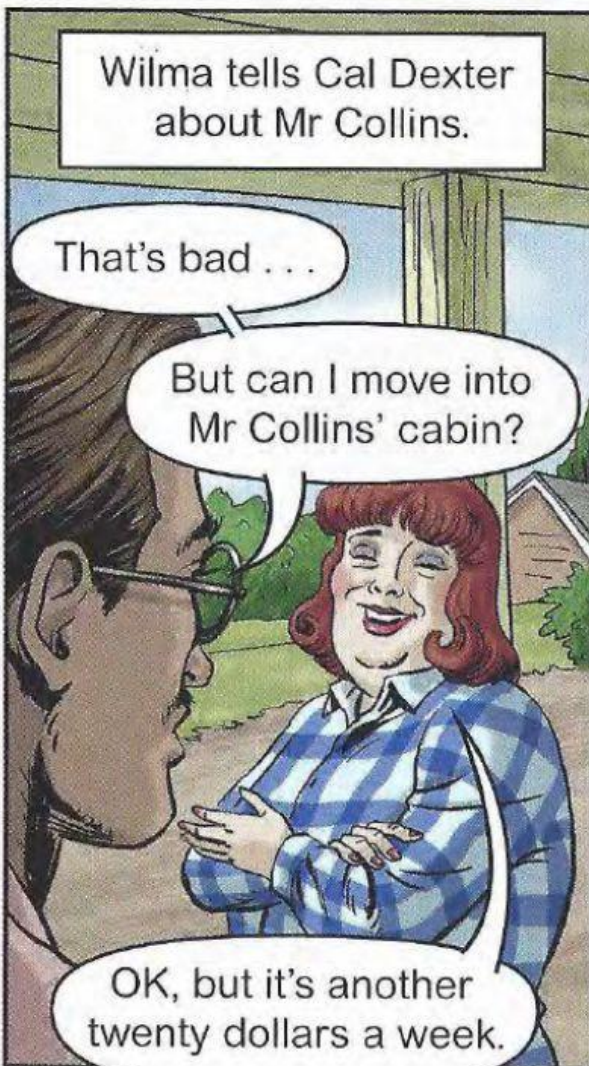


But it is too late.

The next morning, a police car arrives at the Blue Lake Cabins. The policemen tell Wilma about Eddie.





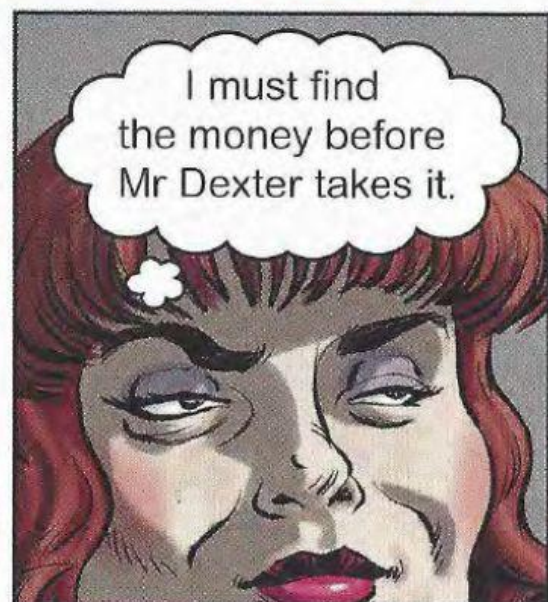
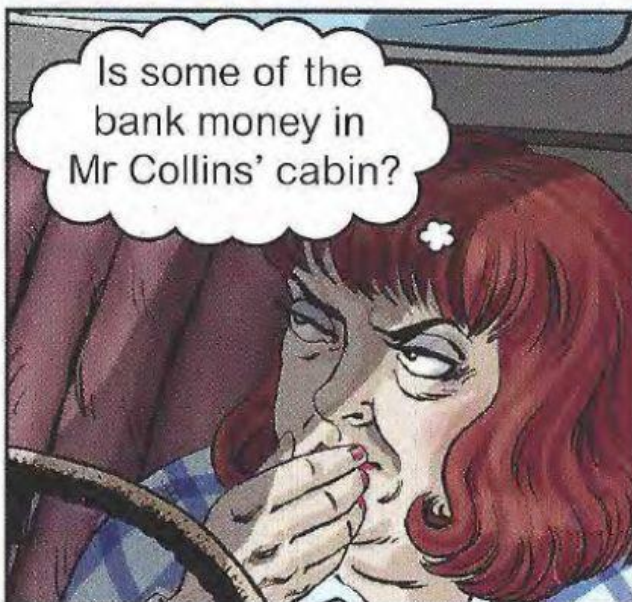
Wilma goes to Eddie's cabin. She puts his things in his bag.

walk by the lake.



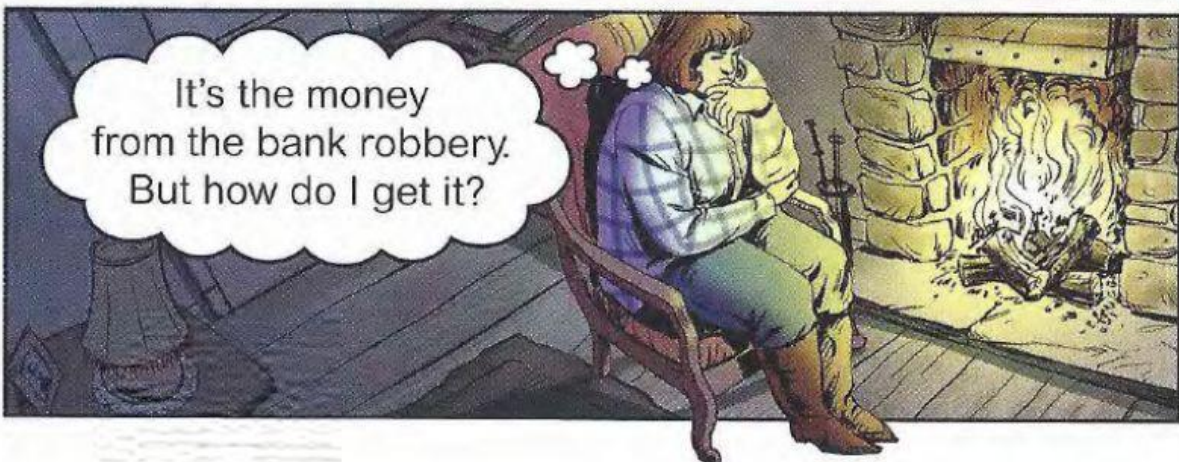
Has Dexter

to do with it?



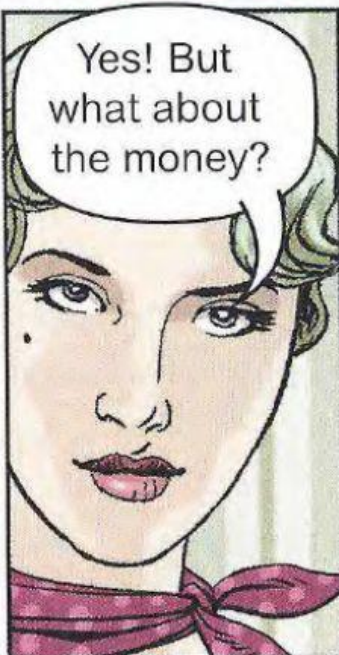
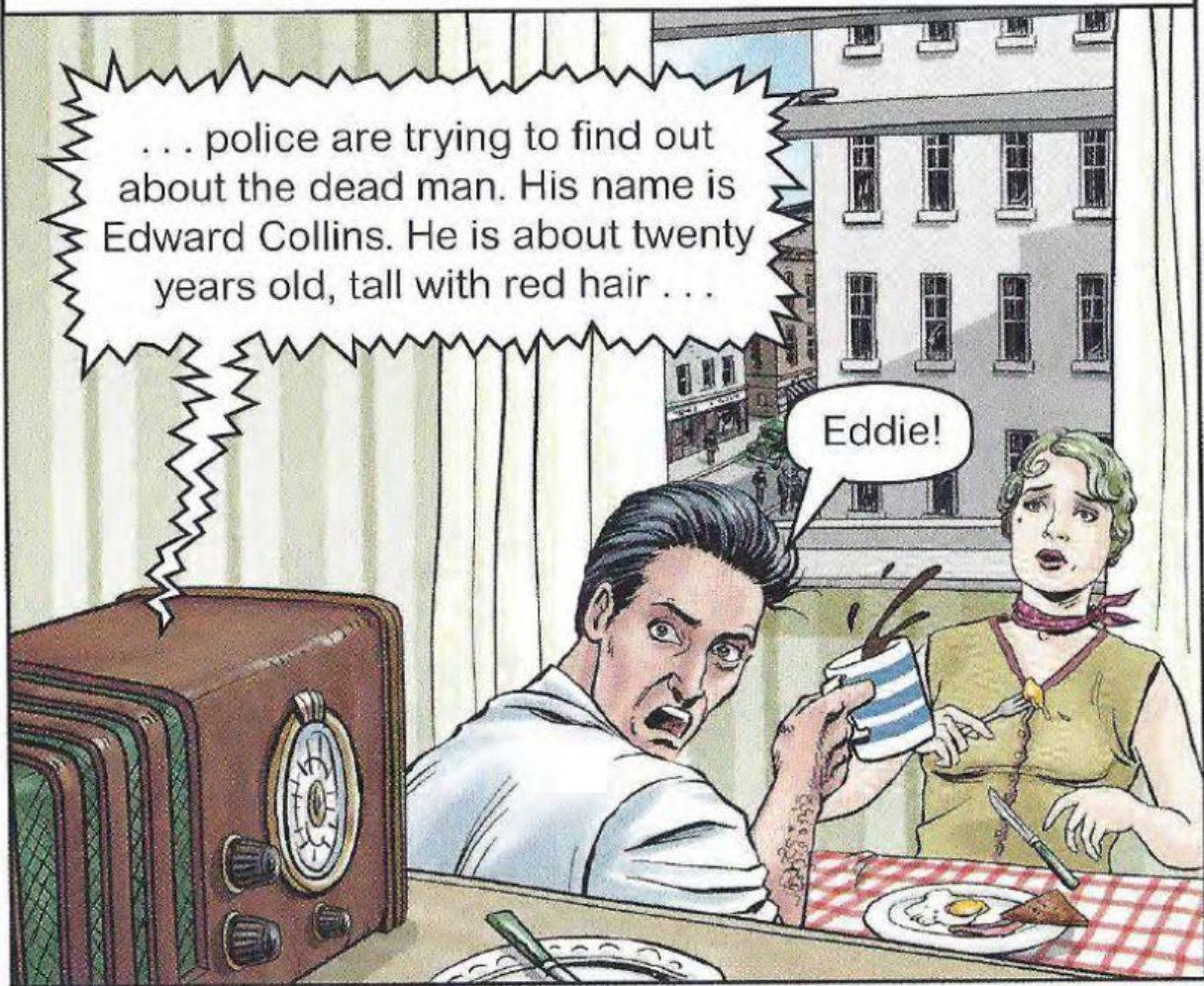
Three thousand dollars!

But how do I get it?



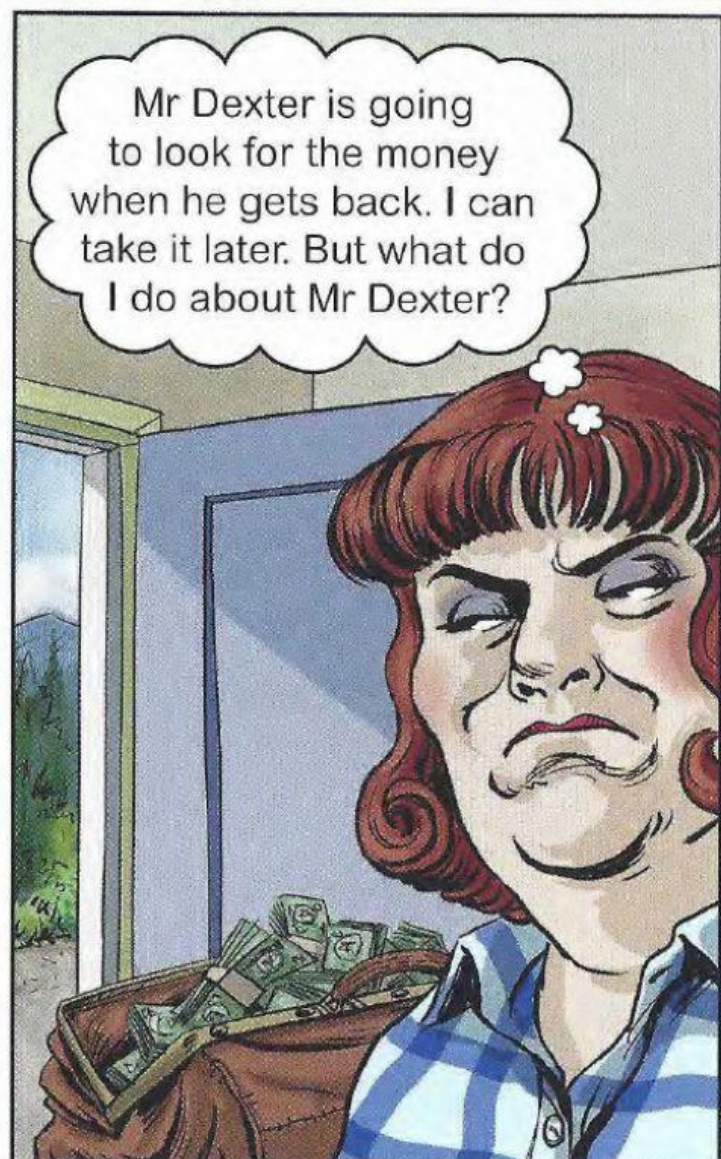


In a different town, Joe and Blanche are listening to the news. It is about a car accident near the Blue Lake Cabins.



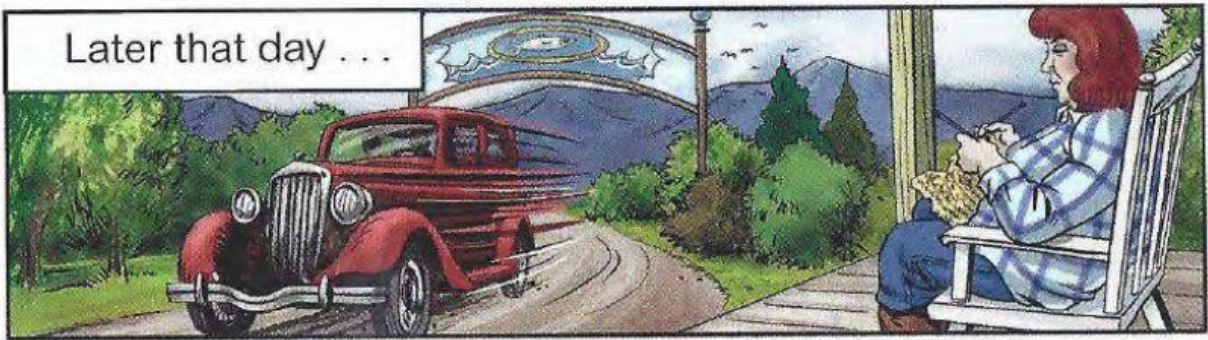


That afternoon, Cal goes out onto the lake.

A young man with money! That's interesting.

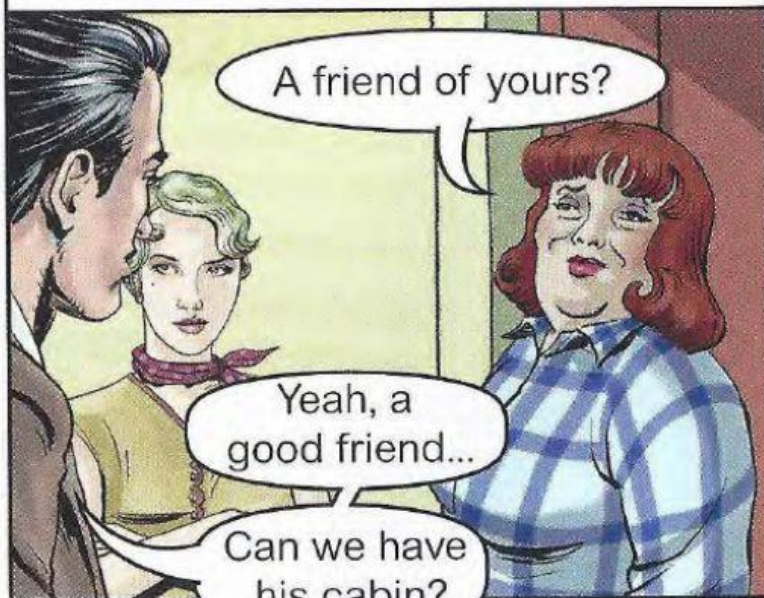


Joe asks Wilma about Edward Collins.
