

some	• plural; • affirmative sentence (+)	There are <i>some apples</i> .
any	• plural, • negative sentence (-), • interrogative sentence (?)	There aren't <i>any apples</i> . Are there <i>any apples</i> ?
no	• affirmative verb - negative meaning	There are <i>no apples</i> . (x)
