Argentina National Team is also known as La Albiceleste. They _____ (appear) in five World Cup finals. Argentina, _____ (lead) by Lionel Messi, made their fifth appearance in a World Cup final in 2014, again losing to Germany 1–0 during extra-time. In the history of World Cups, Argentina National Team faced Germany in 7 opportunities, with 1 win, 2 draws and 4 losses. Since their beginning in 1902, the Argentina national team has appeared in five FIFA World Cup finals. The team also won the 1992 FIFA Confederations Cup. Argentina _____ (also be) very successful in the Copa América, winning it 15 times, most recently led by Lionel Messi in 2021. They are currently tied with Uruguay in most wins. Argentina is the most successful team in the CONMEBOL–UEFA Cup of Champions, having won it twice (1993 and 2022).

Lionel Scaloni's team _____ (win) 35 games unbeaten so far -- dating back to 2019.

Read the five short articles below. Choose from the articles (A to E) and complete the answer grid. The articles may be chosen more than once. One has been done for you as an example.

A. Spain is one of eight national teams to have been crowned world champions, having participated in a total of 16 of 22 FIFA World Cups and qualifying consistently since 1978. Spain is becoming the first European team to win a FIFA World Cup held outside of Europe in 2010. From 2008 to 2013, Spain won the FIFA Team of the Year, the second-most of any nation, behind only

B. Germany is one of the most successful national teams in international competitions, having won four World Cups (1954, 1974, 1990, 2014), three European Championships (1972, 1980, 1996), and one Confederations Cup (2017). They have also been runners-up three times in the European Championships, four times in the World Cup, and a further four third-place finishes at World Cups. Germany is also the only European nation that has won a FIFA World Cup in the Americas.

C. England is the oldest national team in football. England is one of eight nations to have won the World Cup. England has qualified for the World Cup 16 times. It won the 1966 World Cup Final, a tournament it also hosted, and finished fourth in both 1990 and 2018. England has never won the European Championship, with its best performance to date being runners-up in 2020.

D. Brazil is the most successful national team in the FIFA World Cup, being crowned winner five times: 1958, 1962, 1970, 1994 and 2002. It holds a record of 73 victories in 109 matches played, 124-goal difference, 237 points, and 18 losses. It is the only national team to have played in all World Cup editions without any absence nor need for playoffs, and the only team to have won the World Cup on four different continents.

E. La Selección (National Team), also known as La Albiceleste, has appeared in five World Cup finals. Argentina won in the final in 1978. Argentina won again in 1986. They were the runners-up in the World Cup finals in 1990 and 2014. Argentina has also won the Copa América 15 times. The team also won the 1992 FIFA Confederations Cup. Argentina is the most successful team in the CONMEBOL-UEFA Cup of Champions. Argentina is known for having rivalries with Brazil, Uruguay, England, and Germany.
