ceremony (n.)

- a situation in which people are governed in an unfair and cruel way and prevented from having opportunities and freedom

citizen (n.)

- a person who is a member of a particular country and who has rights because of being born there or because of being given rights

commemorate (v.)

- the feeling of loving your own country more than any others and being proud of it

diversity (n.)

- a change in the way a country is governed, usually to a different political system and often using violence or war

oppression (n.)

- to remember officially and give respect to a great person or event

patriotism (n.)

- a set of formal acts performed on important social or religious occasions

revolution (n.)

- a range of different things or people
