

Children's Cold & Allergy Medicine

Uses

- temporarily relieves nasal congestion due to the common cold, hay fever or other upper respiratory allergies, or associated with sinusitis
- temporarily relieves these symptoms due to hay fever (allergic rhinitis):
 - runny nose • sneezing • itchy, watery eyes
 - itching of the nose or throat
- temporarily restores freer breathing through the nose

Directions

- do not take more than 4 doses in any 24-hour period

Age	Dose
adults and children 12 years and over	4 tsp every 4 hours
children 6 to under 12 years	2 tsp every 4 hours
children under 6 years	ask a doctor
