

Podstawowa różnica jest taka, że przymiotniki z końcówką -ed opisują nasze uczucia, natomiast przymiotniki z końcówką -ing opisują efekt, rezultat.

Przymiotniki -ing zwykle używamy do opisywania osób, miejsc czy rzeczy.

This trip is relaxing and very fun. - Ta wycieczka jest relaksująca i zabawna.

Przymiotniki -ed pomagają nam opisać nasze uczucia.

I'm not interested in this book. - Nie jestem zainteresowany tą książką.
I'm relaxed after my long holiday. - Jestem wypoczęty po moich długich wakacjach.
