By the end of this month, she'll have been working for 6 years    He will have completed his report by now

She'll be travelling to her office by now    Will you be needing anything else, Madam?

The new programme will be showing on TV next Monday    It's 10pm, she will have arrived home by now

I('m seeing) 'll be seeing Mike this afternoon    This time next week, I'll be starting my holidays

He was going to eat, but watched a film instead    The king is to open the new hospital on Friday

You are to shut all the windows at noon    The train to Manchester is due at 12pm

Students are not to eat in the Assembly Hall    The videocall is about/bound to be cancelled  
=on the verge/point/brink of being cancelled
