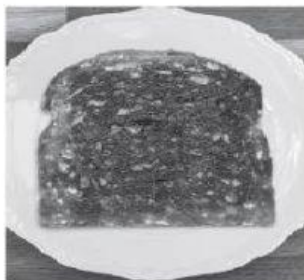

Listening Strategy: Attitudes

In some listening passages, you may be asked about a speaker's attitude about a topic. You will have to identify a speaker's opinion, feeling, or belief about something. A speaker's attitude may be stated directly or it may only be implied. The words a speaker uses can show you the attitude. This type of question is most common in Parts 3 and 4 of the test.

Common Attitude Questions and Words:

- What is the student's **impression** of ... ?
- How does the woman **feel** about ... ?
- What does the professor **mean** when she says ... ?
- What does the man **think** about ... ?
- What is the employee's **opinion** about ... ?
- What is the server's **attitude** ... ?
- What does the customer **believe** about ... ?

Listening to the tone of a speaker's voice can give a hint as to attitude. How a speaker responds to a statement will also show attitude.

Read the following example:

Ex Listen to the conversation and choose the best answer.

W: Look at this burger!

M: Why? Is there something wrong with it?

W: Yes, it's totally undercooked! Look, it's red inside.

M: Oh, it's just a little pink. It looks good.

W: I'm going to send it back.

M: Don't send it back. I'll eat it.

W: OK, I'll eat your pasta instead.

undercooked = not cooked long enough

good = tasty, delicious, worth eating

→ implied information
