You will need to synthesize what you see in the graphic and what you hear in order to answer at least one of the questions for that conversation or talk.

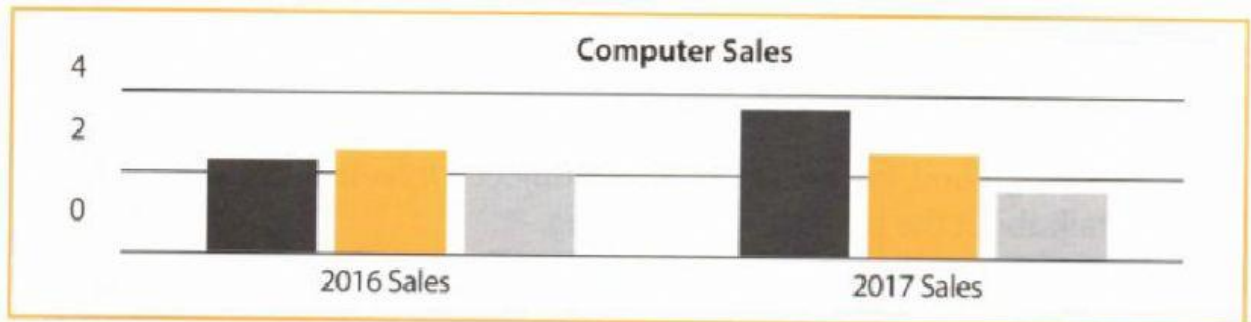
