Ott vannak a verm .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The ditches are there</i>
Temessük be a verm .	Plural, Accusative	<i>Let's fill in the ditches.</i>
Bezárják a malm . (malom)	Singular, Accusative	<i>They are closing the mill.</i>
Vannak ott malm .	Plural, Nominative	<i>There are mills there.</i>
Láttad már a malm ?	Plural, Accusative	<i>Have you seen the mills?</i>
Megszervezték a lakodal . (lakodalom)	Singular, Accusative	<i>They organized the wedding.</i>
Itt lesznek a lakodalm .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The weddings will take place here.</i>
Szeretem a lakodalm .	Plural, Accusative	<i>I like weddings.</i>
Megtaláltam a cső . (cső)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I found the pipe.</i>
Ott futnak a cső .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The pipes are running there.</i>
Szét szedtem a cső .	Plural, Accusative	<i>I disassembled the pipes.</i>

Imádom a hav . (hó)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I love snow.</i>
Lenyírom a fűv . (grass)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I mow the lawn.</i>
Ezek gyógyító fűv .	Plural, Nominative	<i>These are healing grasses.</i>
Megtaláltam a fűv .	Plural, Accusative	<i>I have found the grasses.</i>
Láttam a lov . (ló)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I saw the horse.</i>
Megetette a lov .	Plural, Accusative	<i>She fed the horses.</i>
Vágtáznak a lov .	Plural, Nominative	<i>The horses are galloping.</i>
Megkerestem azt a tav . (tó)	Singular, Accusative	<i>I searched for that lake.</i>
Szépek ezek a tav .	Plural, Nominative	<i>These lakes are nice.</i>
Ismered ezeket a tav ?	Plural, Accusative	<i>Do you know these lakes?</i>
