A terem van.	Inessivus	<i>It is in the room.</i>
Kijönnek a terem .	Elativus	<i>They come out from the hall.</i>
Bemegy a terem .	Illativus	<i>She goes into the hall.</i>
Beleesik a verem .	Illativus	<i>He falls into the ditch.</i>
Kimászott a verem .	Elativus	<i>He climbed out of the ditch.</i>
Mit hallottál a malom ?	Delativus	<i>What have you heard of the mill?</i>
A malom nézett.	Sublativus	<i>She looked at the mill.</i>
A cica a malm ült.	Superessivus	<i>The cat was sittin gon the mill.</i>
Megyünk a lakodalom .	Illativus	<i>We are going to the wedding.</i>
Mesélsz a lakodalom ?	Delativus	<i>Are you going to tell me about the wedding?</i>
A kutya a cső ült.	Inessivus	<i>The dog was sitting in the pipe.</i>
A férfi a cső ült.	Sublativus	<i>The man sat onto the pipe.</i>
Behúzott a cső .	Illativus	<i>She tricked me. (Literally: She drew me into the pipe.)</i>
Ne lépj a fű .	Sublativus	<i>Don't step on the grass.</i>
A füv áll.	Superessivus	<i>She is standing on the grass.</i>
A ló ül.	Sublativus	<i>He sits on the horse.</i>
A lov ül.	Superessivus	<i>He is sitting on the horse</i>

Úszott a tó	Inessivus	<i>She was swimming in the lake..</i>
Nem megyek be a tó	Illativus	<i>I am not going into the lake.</i>
Vigyázott a ház	Sublativus	<i>He was guarding the house.</i>
Előugrott a bokor	Elativus	<i>She jumped out of the bush.</i>
Elbújt a bokor	Illativus	<i>He hid himself in the bush.</i>
Ott volt a bokor	Inessivus	<i>It was in the bush.</i>
