

**during** refers to the whole time of an action or an event (during the concert, during the summer)

**for** refers to numbers or specified time (for 5 years, for a long time)

**in** refers to a month, a season, an exact year or a century, an event that will happen after some period of time (in two weeks), in set expressions (in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening)

**Add in, during or for**

1. I didn't feel cold .....the night.
2. His grandfather fought in the army.....the First World War.
3. I haven't seen you .....ages!
4. Our flight to New York was delayed .....seven hours.
5. I don't remember the exact date, but it happened .....the day.
6. Let's meet .....ten days.
7. Everybody danced.....the wedding.
8. What did you do .....the morning?
9. I met him.....my holidays in summer.
10. I used to visit him.....my stay in London.
