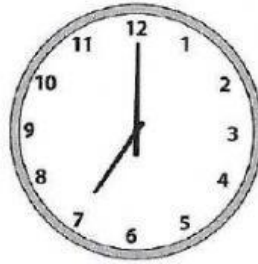
Question 4: Listen for what the girl says about the time of the programme.

Question 5: Listen for the word 'tomorrow' – the answer comes after this.

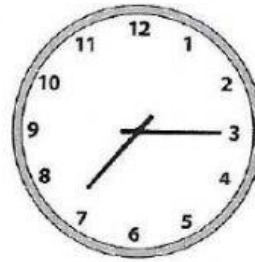
