- J'utilise un PRESENT PERFECT en anglais, mais je traduis par du **PRESENT** quand j'utilise FOR et SINCE.

Dans ces phrases, on parle donc au présent, mais l'action à commencé dans le passé.

On parle donc bien de continuité passé-présent.
