

- For est utilisé pour parler d'une DUREE, Since est utilisé pour parler d'UN POINT DE DEPART.

- J'utilise un PRESENT PERFECT en anglais, mais je traduis par du PRESENT quand j'utilise FOR et SINCE.

**Dans ces phrases, on parle donc au présent, mais l'action à commencé dans le passé.**

**On parle donc bien de continuité passé-présent.**
