Ariana Grande was born on June 26th, 1993, in Florida, USA, but she currently resides in Beverly Hills, California. Her half-brother, Frankie, is an American dancer, actor, singer and YouTube personality. Ariana's music is pop; it is called popular because it is distributed to large audiences and you can enjoy it even with or without musical training. As a child, Ariana performed in the musicals *The Wizard of Oz* and *Beauty and the Beast*. When she was 13, she decided to dedicate to her music career. It was the right decision because only two years later she won a National Youth Theatre Association Award for her role in the musical '13', in 2008. Her first single appeared in 2011, and her first album in 2013.
