Most new airships can also travel further distances and carry heavier loads than previous models. And unlike aeroplanes, they can take off and land vertically, 4) ..... like a helicopter. This means that they can be very useful when large groups of people need to travel to destinations without an airport. With the world on the verge of an energy crisis, given its low fuel-usage, airships could become one of the most popular modes of transport in the future.
