Q1) A carton holds 36 sets of screwdrivers. One set has 12 screwdrivers. How many screwdrivers can be packed in 65 such cartons?

Q2) A carton holds 15 packets of biscuits. Each packet has 5 biscuits. How many biscuits can be packed in 10 cartons?

Q3) During a practice session, Frank swims an average of 19 laps in an hour. If he were to attend 52 practice sessions, how many laps will he be able to cover on an average?

Q4) A small-time tour operator owns a fleet of 8 cars of the same make. Each car is filled with 2 litres of engine oil. How many litres in all have been filled in the cars?

Q5) A rectangle is 65 inches long and 24 inches wide.
Find the area of the rectangle.

(Area of a rectangle = length*width)

Q6) A flashlight requires 83 batteries to function. How many batteries in all would 27 such flashlights require?

Q7) Sunil and his 4 friends are deciding on the games that they want to play on his birthday. If each game they decided on takes 29 minutes to end and they prepared a total of 14 games, in how much time will they be able to finish all the games they decided to play?
