Past continuous & past simple | when & while

We often use the past continuous and the past simple together. The **past continuous** describes an action or situation that was in progress, and the **past simple** describes a completed action.

*The burglar **was climbing** through the window when the police officer **saw** him.*

*When I **went out**, it **was raining**.*

We connect the actions with *when* and *while*.

*I **was cooking** dinner when I **heard** a loud noise.*

*When / While I **was reading** a magazine, the thief **took** my bag.*
