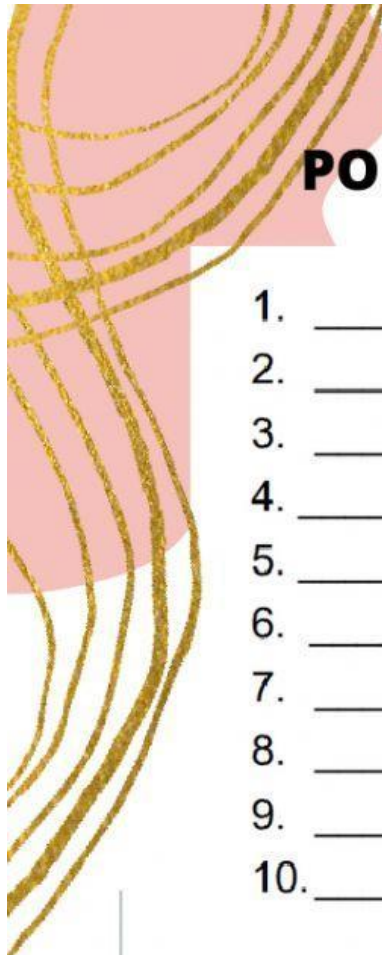
Rice (*arroz*)
